1. HAVE YOU ALWAYS BEEN A CHRISTIAN?

No I was born in Clara Street in a bedroom above the shop. After 1 year we moved as a family to Foxglove Street where I lived until I was married. My mother & father at that time were not Christians, but sent me to Grove Sunday School until I was about 10/11 years old. The next time I went back to church again was when I got saved on the 17th February 1981. I was 27. In the years in between I went to Orangefield Boys School, I was only interested in sport, art, woodwork and metalwork. At the age of 13 I started drinking alcohol I continued until I was 27. I had wasted years and bad experiences through drink.

2. HOW DID YOU BECOME A CHRISTIAN?

I was under conviction of sin for over a year. I lived for self, football, music and drink. I got caught up in the troubles over the years and did what most teenagers did at that time. I worked in the shipyard for 11 years as a plater/steelworker. My friend who I worked with told me that I needed the Lord Jesus Christ in my life and that he would forgive me from my sins. That night I accepted the Lord Jesus as my Saviour.

3. WHAT DO YOU ENJOY MOST ABOUT THE WORK OF CAFE GROVE?

I enjoy meeting people and sharing my faith and testimony with others.

4 DO YOU HAVE A FAVOURITE BIBLE VERSE AND WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO YOU?

1 Cor ch 1 v27 tells me that God can use ordinary people like me to share the gospel with others. It's not our ability but availability to God.

2 Cor ch 5 v 17 means to me that our old life is past and we have a new life purpose and hope in the Lord Jesus.
